WARDEN MESSAGE: H1N1 INFLUENZA INFORMATION

This warden message is to inform American citizens living in or traveling to Macedonia that there have been no reports of confirmed cases of H1N1 influenza in Macedonia. The Government of Macedonia has instituted health screening of air passengers coming in from any country with H1N1 influenza, including the United States. If an individual is suspected of being infected with H1N1 influenza, s/he will be taken to the Clinic of Infectious Diseases in Skopje for additional screening.
