WARDEN MESSAGE – BRIDGE COLLAPSE NEAR MACEDONIAN-BULGARIAN BORDER

The U.S. Embassy has received information from the Macedonian Ministry of Interior that a bridge collapsed due to poor weather conditions five kilometers from the Macedonian-Bulgarian border near Gyueshevo on the Bulgarian side (near the Deve Bair border crossing on the Macedonian side). The road is completely blocked. Anyone attempting to travel between Macedonia and Bulgaria should use the border crossings at Delcevo or Novo Selo. At this time, there is no estimate on how long the road will remain closed. The U.S. Embassy will provide updates on the road closure as they become available.
